



**VILLAGE OF HYDE PARK
PLANNING COMMISSION**

Minutes of May 11, 2022

The duly warned regular meeting of the Planning Commission was held May 11, 2022 in the Community Room.

Members: Chair Riki French, Jack Anderson, Peter Gallo, Dan Young and Sue Trainor

Staff: Carol Robertson, General Manager, Karen Wescom, Clerk/Treasurer, Loren Leahy, Zoning Administrator

Chair Riki French called the regular meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Commissioners welcomed Sue Trainor to her first meeting. There were no additions or revisions to the agenda.

At the request of a resident, the GM recalled the resident's complaint of early morning mechanical equipment noise and lack of enforcement of the town noise ordinance. There was also a discussion speeding traffic within the Village. There was a consensus that the Chair would invite Sheriff Roger Marcoux to a future meeting toward improving the quality of life and safety in the community. There were no other Village issues or concerns.

The Chair gave an update on the Lamoille County Planning Commission, noting that Amy Olsen, Director of the Lanpher Memorial Library was nominated for the Marvin Award and received Honorable Mention.

The GM reported that Seth Jensen, Planner with the Lamoille County Planning Commission, would attend the June 8 meeting for zoning ordinance/bylaw discussion.

Motion by Dan Young and second by Peter Gallo to approve the minutes of April 20, 2022. The motion carried, with Sue Trainor abstaining since this is her first meeting.

The GM discussed the lack of adequate and customary utility notice given by the town to the Hyde Park Utilities Foreman prior to the town paving Eden St. and Prospect St. There was a discussion of negative impacts when adequate/customary notice is not received. There was a consensus that the GM bring a policy to the Board of Trustees for consideration. The policy should inform the town of adequate/customary utility notice and mitigate expense to Hyde Park water and wastewater ratepayers due to failure to receive adequate/customary notice.

There being no further business, motion by Dan Young and second by Peter Gallo to adjourn the meeting at 6:55 p.m. The motion carried.
