The meeting was recorded via Zoom. Meeting called to order by Eric Williams and Riki French, Chairs, at 6:02pm and 6:03pm. 18 19 **Joint Planning Commission Meeting** 20 21 1. Welcome, changes to the agenda, if any, and Public Comment – Leslie Rollins presented a plaque 22 from Healthy Lamoille Valley to the Hyde Park Planning Commissions for the Health Chapter of the 23 Municipal Plan. 24 2. Energy Goals – Discussion – Brian Evans-Mongeon presented changes to LCPC with recommendations 25 to consolidate where appropriate to reduce redundancy, reflect capacity, etc. Marc Mastrangelo presented 26 updated energy chapter edits and comments from Meghan Rodier. Zoning regulations for childcare were 27 mentioned. Hydropower was discussed, noting 2 inactive hydro utilities in Hyde Park. The Municipal 28 Plan is required to reference discouraging fragmentation of core forest blocks and wildlife habitats. 29 Stephen McDonald stated maps with overlays are available on the Town website showing the forest 30 blocks and habitat areas, and Marc Mastrangelo stated the map can be a part of the Municipal Plan. Riki 31 French stated the types of renewable energy should be named individually. Meghan Rodier submitted 32 notes with requirements to consider, including ACT 174. Sue Trainor noted the misspelling of 33 "trafficking" on the second to last bullet of the energy policies. The 6th bullet under Energy

the 3rd bullet under Chapter 5 transportation policies and noted downstream concerns.

Recommendations was discussed. Note: The Hyde Park Energy Committee is now the Hyde Park Energy and Conservation Committee. The 8th bullet under Energy Recommendations were discussed for word

smithing, and reference to transportation is required in the energy chapter. Richard Pearson referenced

 6:25pm Adoption Timeline Review The adoption timeline was discussed as presented with projected hearings in September, October and December. A summary sheet of changes was requested to be provided by LCPC, and Marc Mastrangelo noted this may be possible, though there may also be labor concerns. Marc Mastrangelo confirmed that LCPC will prepare the hearing notices and coordinate with newspapers, and the Town and Village are responsible for posting the physical notices.

Eric Williams noted that a lot of people he has talked to view this as the work of the government and are not interested.
